ADMINISTERING THE SURVEYS

- **In-class survey, Jan. 9-Feb. 1, 2013**
 - 51 classes participated
 - Enrollment = 2905
 - Completed surveys = 2140
 - Overall response rate = 74%
- **On-line survey, Feb. 12 – March 21, 2013**
 - 24,570 email invitations sent; Feb. 12 & Feb. 21
 - Completed surveys = 2311
 - Response rate (adjusted for in-class participation) = 10%
- **Total participation = 4451**
 - Participation rate = 18% of undergraduate population
